As part of this year's trip our team has plans to help with the ongoing construction of the Haven On The Hill Children's Home near Gatundu, Kenya.

In addition we will be doing ministry such as home visits to the local people delivering much needed clothes, health supplies, Bibles and more.

We will also be planning to hold a Vacation Bible School to over 250 plus children at the school close by.

Visit the world's third largest slum called Kibera, on the outskirts of Niarobi and love on and minister to the children that are part of the Miracle Children Center there.

Hold a special outdoor movie night outreach where on our last trip hundreds of people attended with close to a hundred indicating their accepting Christ as savior.

Our team will also have other opportunities for both ministry and to take time for rest and reflection.

The great thing about a trip like this is that Inheritance World Ministries has done all the work for you and

will even show you exactly how your costs for such a trip can be covered. But even so there are still people that even though they feel God calling them will still say NO!

and taken to the police station. She was then taken in by her Mother's sister who she now lives with.

Her aunt then seeing the need for help brought her to attend the Miracle & Victory Children's Center where she is provided with food, clothing, education and the hope of knowing Jesus!

Simon was reported to have been abandoned by his mother in November of 2009.

The whereabouts of his mother is not known and no other relatives have claimed him.

Simons name was listed only as Mohammad on the children's report.

Simon lives at the Haven On The Hill Children's Home near Gatundu, Kenya where he along with his many other "Brothers" are well cared for and have the opportunity to know Jesus. He is such a blessing through both his presence and his smile!
