In just about 45 days from the time you read this our team should be on a jet plane headed over 7000 miles from our place of departure to our place of arrival in Kenya, East Africa!



There is still much to do, and the team has been diligent in continuing to accept the task of raising the funds required to accomplish the mission laid before them.

On May 23rd much of our team was assembled at Hobby Lobby in Easton hosting a

bake sale.

Setting up two tables at each entrance they shared not only their donated baked goods and drinks they received, but all about the mission with many of the people that passed by there stations.

There were continuous looping videos that people had the opportunity to view, along with color brochures detailing what our ministry is all about.

In addition the team through the generosity of others was able to bring in over \$800. Closing the gap on the total budget we are striving to meet.

June 6th found our team members once again raising funds at the home of one of our team members at the huge Pen Ar-

gyl Yard Sale that takes place each year.

Raising funds hasn't been easy. But then again nothing notable or life changing rarely is.

We still have 1 1/2 months to



go and in faith we are trusting God to supply the approx. \$10,000 left to meet our goal!

This Month's Focus On Ministry

Team Evangelism Training

On June 7th our team gathered together for our 4th Mission Meeting and Team Training.

With many of the logistics of passports, shots, expectations, scheduling and more out of the way for now it was time for our

team to focus on the heart of our mission which is ministry and evangelism.

Over the course of about 2 1/2 hours our team members were bombarded with and learned multiply strategies in preparation in sharing the good news about Jesus more effectively. As an

overview they learned about the only 5 types of people they will ever share their faith with. How to determine what their job is at the time, based on the person they are sharing with. Whether it is to plant a seed, water that seed, challenge that person to receive Christ, help cultivate that persons life from the weeds that

are keeping them from growing, or learning to teach others already growing in Christ.

We also covered our schedule and outline in order to understand how better we will host a Vacation Bible School to about 270 children at one of the local schools while in Kenya.

They also learned of a movie outreach we will be holding on the grounds of the Haven on the Hill Children's home we will be helping to construct and be staying at.

The movie night outreach is promoted during the final day of our Vacation Bible School and so it brings hundreds of the locals from all around as they gather with expectation to see the Jesus film projected on a large outdoor screen in their own language of Kikuyu. After which a personal gospel presentation is given with the hope of seeing many find Christ as their Savior.

On yet another day the team will be visiting the slum of Kibera experiencing and ministering to just some of it's 800,000 residents. People housed in some of the worst living conditions on earth. As we travel through the slum our hope is to have opportunity to share our lives with the lives of those living there and of course Jesus.

Plans are also set for a large community outreach to the locals around the Haven on the Hill Children's home as they receive not only clothes and necessities both we and Haven have provide, but the message of hope in Jesus as well and further opportunities are in place for our team to also share during worship service at one or two of the churches we are scheduled to visit.

In helping educate our team in many of the aspects of evangelism we have tried to remove the fear factor of sharing our faith from the equation. In doing this and helping each team member see the significance that their particular role might play in and outreach or talk will hopefully allow them to truly fulfill their job as a messenger of the Gospel.

Working through our training our goals are to equip each person whether gifted as an evangelist or not in some way to share their faith through a combination of scripture, illustration, application, their personal testimony, drama, props, skits, sketch-board or what have you.

With eternity hanging in the balance for so many people and just 15 days from start to finish to perform all the ministry we have planned it is important each one of our team go into the battle fully equipped and prepared to change lives as God leads them in bringing others to Him.

Whether having opportunity to share Christ with the person sitting next to them on the plane or during a house visit to one of the locals it is our hope that what our team has had the opportunity to learn and take hold of will stay with them for many days and hopefully even years after this trip is over, and that they would continue on in growing the Kingdom of God, whether one person or many at a time!

Many of the larger items have already been put in place like our US transportation deposits to cover our transportation to and from the airport here and our hotel reservations and deposit secured for our first night in Nairobi (we arrive late the first night). Our airline ticket deposit have already been received and booked with final balances being paid this month.

In planning a trip of this size and magnitude there is a great deal of planning and expense that must go into it , but even with all the work we expect the ongoing outcome of lives touched to far exceed the cost involved.

If you were wondering as to what items need to be covered under our budget to pull off a trip like this, here are just some that make up the list: US transportation, Airfare, Food, Construction Materials, Ministry Supplies, Special Lodging, In Country Transportation, Laundry, Cooks, Construction Assistance, Team visas, Team Medical Evacuation Insurance, Duffel Bags & Tee Shirts, Security Guards, Tools, Travel Meals, and much more!

With much prayer and through God's direction and help we have been able to remain on track financially in reaching our goals so far. So with only about 6 weeks left we are still praying and trusting for the final funds to come in.
