2019 Kenya Mission Trip Update (MUST READ TO THE END)!!!

Time really does fly by doesn't it?

We are coming up on almost two years since our last mission trip to Kenya Africa and because of health issues and taking some down time to recover emotionally, I haven't taken the opportunity to reach out and share with you all that happened on that trip! So I do apologize.

First off I must say that I believe that after doing and leading mission trips for almost 30 years this trip was the hardest I have ever done

There seemed to be so much opposition in every step of the planning. From the very time our board members approved the trip it was an uphill battle spiritually to try and make it all come together.

When ever something like this takes place I can usually assume that something great is going to come out of it and this trip was no exception to the rule.

After all the struggles we faced booking flights, promoting the trip and other issues our team of 19

people finally stepped off the plane onto African soil, but the battle continued.

The first few days we worked on several construction projects that needed to be done around the Haven that included: Moving and scrubbing over 300 solid stone block that could then be laid by the fundis (Kenyan Workers); painting of the fence surrounding the propane tank as well as other painting; designing and building a 12 x 18 foot 16" high stage; designing and building a three tier high portable scaffold system; assembling six treadle sewing machines to be used to train local women sewing so that they could start a new business; and sewing loops in 60 x 8 foot lengths of fabric and then draping them from the ceiling of the dining hall to eliminate the noise and echo in the building.

Although we were successful in carrying out much of what we

planned to do the enemy was not happy and so difficulties continued.

Much of the team was suffering from sicknesses of different kinds. I personally was in bed sick for 3 days straight. But even with all the sickness it was evident through our work and message that we were having an impact here, but wouldn't realize just how much until the next day after church.

It was our plan to travel to Pastor Rafael's church several miles away and then travel on to Nakuru were the team would enjoy a much needed rest by going on safari.

I had been asked to preach at church and so prepared a sermon to share, but in the middle of the night before church God woke me up from my sleep and spoke to my heart that the sermon I had prepared was not the one he wanted me to share. He expressed to me...

that he wanted me to talk about having communion with him and not just at church on Sundays, but daily and throughout the day.

As I lay there in bed God revealed to me each verse I was to use and each personal story to go with it and after about a half hour is went back to sleep. Early the next morning I wrote down everything God shared with me although I was a little apprehensive to share it with everyone at church. But as I began to share the message God had given me I began to see tears in people eyes and running down their faces. Heads were nodding up and down and they were intent to hearing the message.

After I sat down the Pastor came up front and invited anyone that wanted to, to come forward in hopes of finding a deeper communion with God. I was amazed as much of the church came forward, but the most incredible part was when the Pastor invited me and Phil (from the Haven) to his office in an outbuilding by the church. As we sat down he said these words to me, "The message you spoke today was for me. I have been dealing

with issues lately, but after hearing your message I now have the strength to continue."

I don't know if this Pastor was ready to quit the ministry or not, but it was clear that God had touched him and many others as well.

Through the remaining days people would continue to be touched by God's goodness and strengthened as well, including team members.

Our plan was to show the Jesus Film to the community

one night, but our video projector broke unexpectedly. I tried to fix it by was unsuccessful, but despite the continued struggles God was clearly doing something in the hearts of people.

We also performed other ministry outside the Haven and also traveled to the Kibera slum just outside Nairobi to meet with our other ministry partner Monica at the Victory and Miracle Children's Centre. This center provides food and education to over 300 children, some of which are orphaned and live at the centre.

As always Monica shared her story of how God rescued her and called her from the poverty of the slum to minister to the children there and as always it was a powerful and touching message of God's power and grace.


When our trip was over I must admit that I was physically, emotionally and spiritually spent! I was sick for most of the following month with respritory issues. I was exhausted and to be honest just wanted to go into hiding to find some rest! Which is a large part of why you haven't received a newsletter or any real updates until now and I think it is important that I share with you the struggles as well as a the victories, because that is real life.

We all face giants and we all become broken at times even in the midst of great conquests, but that just shows us that as we move to do God's work in sharing with and loving others that we need Him and His strength or we will fail.

So I don't know what you are going through right now or what God might have called you to or what giant you need to face, but I want you to know that it is okay to feel broken, tired, exhausted and even afraid. Because that is when we find how little we know, how weak we truly are and how much bigger our God is!!!

So whatever direction God is calling you to go. Go! He will be there every step of the way as it says in Psalm 139:5-6 You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. ⁶ Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

So was our mission trip a success in accomplishing what we felt called to do? I think it was, but I believe we all need to remember it isn't so much about the victory or the defeat as it is about the journey as we travel to get there with God by our side!!!

Having never attempted something like this I spent the next 8 months researching all I could about YouTube and how to develop a channel. What cameras, editing software, formatting, etc. work best, and then once a felt I understood enough I began to work to self film videos for upload.



I must tell you I faced just as much if not more struggles getting the first video uploaded as I did putting together our last mission trip and missions I had a better understanding on how to do.

At one point I almost quit!!! I was so discouraged, but I continued to trust God and move forward. I felt that this was a spiritual battle and if I could just get the first video uploaded I would have won.



Finally after months of figuring things out I uploaded the first video the end of June 2020. After that the following videos although a lot

of work came easier until we now have to date 54 videos uploaded and God has been blessing the channel with almost 14,000 viewers a month!

One of my fears was that I would face a multitude of people commenting after watching the videos saying "I don't want to hear about any of this Jesus stuff", but the exact opposite has happened with so many thanking me for the video and the message.

It has been an amazing journey so far and the great thing about it is that even after God calls me home people will still be hearing about the Gospel as long as YouTube is around.
